
Love for the sea

Today the identity of our municipality is closely linked to the sea and its coastline, to the enjoyment of summer days, to the wealth of marine life that provisions our tables, and to the excitement of sporting competitions.

However, it has not always been this way. Until the mid-20th century, the majority of Ibicencos lived inland with their backs to the sea, toiling on their farms, which yielded better harvests than the sea. The coast was the territory of fishing families, humbler souls, whose labours were not rewarded until the arrival of tourism and its new focus on beaches and enjoyment of the sea.

Today Santa Eulària offers a wide range of diversions for an unforgettable holiday. Do you find gazing at fish under the water more relaxing than meditation? Or do you prefer the excitement of driving a jet ski? Are you, perhaps, travelling with children? In this Guide to the Sea, you'll find information about maritime excursions and glass-bottom boats, charter vessels and routes as well as aquatic activities to suit every preference. These may be divided into three broad categories: fun for the whole family; thrills for the adventurous; and a shot of pure adrenaline. These classifications are mere suggestions – feel free to define your experience in your own terms!

This guide will also apprise you of the wide range of the services provided by the Santa Eulala Yacht Club and the Santa Eulalia Marina as well as the list of registered nautical companies that offer courses, rent out equipment and organise aquatic activities. In short, it provides all the information you need to make the most of your holiday in Santa Eulària. The only thing you'll need to do is prepare for the time of your life. Banana bus

If you like fun and excitement in your family, and you don't mind falling into the briny deep, you're sure to love the feeling of skimming over the sea at top speed, riding on a giant floating tube pulled by a motor boat. Better hold on tight!

Where? - Cala Pada



Pedal boats

Children always like to pedal around on the sea. If a ride on a pedalo is a must for your family's summer holiday, you'll find them for hire at many of our coves and beaches. Then, just set off and explore the lovely nooks and crannies along our coastline!

Where? – Es Figueral, Cala Llenya, Es Canar, Cala Martina, s'Argamassa, Cala Pada, Es Riu and Cala Llonga.

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Santa Eulària des Riu is home to over twenty beaches and coves. Their calm, crystalline waters provide the perfect environment in which to enjoy incredible aquatic experiences that are suitable for the whole family. Dive into whichever activity strikes your fancy!



Ringo

This activity is just as much fun as – if not more than – the banana bus in that the feeling of speed is increased because participants lie front down on a round floating "cookie". The adrenaline rush starts as soon as the boat picks up speed and the tumbles start.

Crazy sofa

Teenage kids go for the wildest aquatic activities, like this inflatable water toy in the shape of a sofa, pulled by a motor boat. Spins, jumps, bumps, tumbles...you won't know what's coming next! If you're travelling with a group and you like to get your adrenaline going, then this high-jinks ride is for you.

Dinghy sailing

Have you ever dreamt of learning how to sail? If so, our municipality offers dinghy sailing courses for all ages that are specially designed to be enjoyed while on holiday. There are also longer courses available for those who live in Ibiza. So don't just sit and stare at the sea – get out and sail the surf!

Kayaking

Virgin beaches, islets, spectacular cliffs and other intriguing marine features seem to arise out of nowhere on the kayak excursions you can take along the Santa Eulària coast. Thanks to the extensive availability of kayaks furnished by specialised companies as well as the many access points to the sea, you'll find it easy to practice this sport during your holiday.

Where? – Es Figueral, Cala Llenya, Es Canar, Cala Martina, s'Argamassa, Cala Pada, Marina Santa Eulalia and Es Riu

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From the depths of the sea, or the majesty of the coast, Santa Eulària exudes beauty wherever you cast your gaze. If you would like to discover its charms at a tranquil pace, this section is for you.



Scuba diving

You'll never discover Ibiza fully until you submerge yourself in its waters. This activity, which is available during the whole season, allows you to discover caves, underwater platforms, walls and posidonia meadows as well as false corals, sponges and all the marine fauna typical of our waters: lobsters, octopi, moray eels, seabream, damselfish, barracudas, croakers, etc.

Where? – You'll find diving centres in Cala Martina, Cala Pada and Marina Santa Eulalia.



Stand-up paddle (SUP)

Our 47-kilometre coastline holds an infinite number of "wow" moments when you travel on a paddle board. There are routes for every skill level and no end to the delightful enclaves you can discover. Even if you have never practised this sport before, you can sign up for guided tours that include an initiation class!

Foilboarding

If you have the soul of a surfer, you'll have a great time whizzing around on a motorised foilboard which reaches speeds of up to 50 km/h. This high-octane activity is available at nautical outlets that specialise in aquatic toys.

Where? – S'Argamassa and Marina Santa Fulala



Flyboarding

Rise up over the water with a propulsion-powered flyboard that is connected by a hose to a watercraft. A huge surge of adrenaline is guaranteed! Once you learn to keep your balance, you can move around, whirling and plunging, according to your level of expertise.

Where? Marina Santa Eulalia

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If you like extreme emotions and unexpected twists while you surf the sea, glide over its surface or submerge yourself in it, Santa Eulària is your place. Here you can enjoy a full range of experiences that let you feel the rush of adrenaline and the thrill of being alive.



Jet skiing (runabout water scooter)

If you like travelling at high velocity, you'll definitely want to take a ride on a jet ski during your Ibiza holiday. The experience will give you a rush of adrenaline while at the same time allowing you to drink in the beauty of our coastline. If you've never driven a jet ski before, now's the time to learn in calm waters off a safe stretch of coast!

Kitesurfing

If you love action, this sport is sure to become one of your favourites. Kitesurfing may be practised along our coasts during low season, but, it is not allowed in summer to ensure the safety of bathers. If you have not yet had the chance to fly this type of power kite, introductory courses are available.

Where? – If you bring your own equipment, you'll find good conditions for kitesurfing at Cala Martina.



Parasailing

Santa Eulària and its coastline are even more impressive from the sky! See for yourself with this fun and exciting activity in which you are lifted up in a parachute that is pulled at top speed by a motor boat. You surely won't forget an experience like this!

Seabob

If you're looking for the maximum subaquatic experience, get behind the handlebars of a diver propulsion vehicle, also known as a seabob. With this underwater scooter, there are no limits and no barriers, regardless of whether you're above or below the sea. It lets you experience absolute space with total freedom, like a free-wheeling shark!

Surfing

If what you like is skimming over the sea, there's no better way to do it than surfing the waves. So, get up on your board and hang ten – provided, of course, that you have an extra gene for balance and some previous experience.

Where? – If you bring your own board, Cala Nova is your beach.



Water-skiing

It is said that this sport combines the best of skiing with the best of summer. If you agree, it's because water-skiing gives you the rush of adrenaline you want and need. So strap on your skis and prepare to enjoy the optimal conditions you'll find along our coast with its soft winds and warm waters.

Where? - Cala Pada




Windsurfing

Whether you're a seasoned windsurfer or you've just decided to take the sport up, you'll find plenty of enjoyment along our coasts, where the winds tend to be gentle and stable. That said, you must keep in mind that the islets and reefs that dot the waters add an extra layer of difficulty.

Where? If you have your own equipment, head to Cala Martina and Cala Nova.

You don't have to be a celebrity to navigate along the Ibicenco coastline, from cove to cove, with a cold drink in your hand





All you have to do is charter a boat, gather together your best group of friends and family, and then sit back for a delightful day on the sea. In Santa Eulària you'll find a wide range of skippered craft for hire, including catamarans, sailboats, yachts, motorboats and llaüts (the traditional island boat).

You can choose the option that best fits your budget, your preferences and the number of people in your group. You can also book outings for more than one day, and, if you really have the soul of a mariner, you can even spend the night on the boat! Regardless of which adventure you choose, the Marina Santa Eulalia will be the departure point for this unforgettable experience in which you can swim in solitary virgin coves, explore Ibiza from a new perspective, and enjoy the pure pleasure of seaborne navigation.

Glass botton boat







During your holiday, you'll have plenty of opportunities to discover our seascapes and enjoy the thrill of sailing. If you don't cast off, it's because you don't want to! During the summer season, several family-run companies in the municipality offer ferry services with multiple departure times. These regular lines shuttle to and from: Es Figueral, Es Canar, Cala Pada, the town of

Santa Eulària, Cala Llonga and Ibiza Town.

In Es Canar, you can also take sightseeing trips on a glass-bottom boat, a fun way to explore Santa Eulària's coastline as well as its seafloor. Another option is a trip to Formentera, or a family outing by the sea, with excursions that span some hours in which you will learn about marine life, go snorkelling with a guide who is also a marine biologist, play with aquatic toys, go on a treasure hunt, and more – a unique experience your children will not forget!



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Es Figueral



Facing the eastern winds, this beautiful beach offers snorkelling for all levels. Just open your eyes and you'll start spotting octopi, painted combers, white seabream, peacock wrasse and other marine creatures that inhabit the ledge of rock and glide through the labyrinthine crevices that open up beneath Es Figueral's craggy waterline.

Total route distance: 470 m

Maximum depth: -4 m


Recommendation: This beach sometimes gets wave surges, in which case, snorkelling

is not advised.

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Whatever your age, it's easy to have fun on our coast by just putting on a pair of goggles and a snorkel tube and wading into the sea. It won't be long before fish start appearing in your field of vision! You can either improvise your own route or try any of these eight special-interest routes.





Pou des Lleó and Canal d'en Martí





The rocky stretch of coast that joins these two coves offers one of the best routes in Santa Eulària. Setting off from the left shore of Pou des Lleó, the path skims over posidonia sea grass to a subaquatic mound transited by gobies and Mediterranean rainbow wrasse. The route carries on past a rocky ridge frequented by bogues and damselfish.



Recommendation: Do not attempt this route if there are winds from the north or east and use a surface marker buoy due to the possible presence of watercraft.

Cala Nova





This route, replete with crevices and hollows, is also great for children! The low level of boat traffic at Cala Nova along with its gently sloping seabed make it perfect for exploring the marine environment. And who might the inhabitants of this aquatic realm be? To name but a few: striped seabream, plaice, bass, anthias, white seabream, painted comber, octopi, etc.

Cala Martina



This 400-metre circular route runs from the fishing huts on the left-hand side to Punta d'es Gat, and then crosses over a posidonia meadow where you can see shoals of porgies, red mullets and seabream. On the way back, you'll skirt the coastline where it's not hard to spot octopi and painted combers.



Recommendation: Use a surface marker buoy and don't cross the boat channel. **GPS location:** 38°59′27.22″N 1°34′28.86″E







S'Argamassa





Snorkelling is as easy as child's play on this fun route that sets off from the left side of the finger pier and runs along a fissured rocky bottom, the perfect home for porgies, Mediterranean rainbow wrasse and white seabream. You can also see peacock wrasse, which in springtime get very busy building their nests. And, if you look hard enough, you can see red mullets hiding in the sand.

Level: Family

Total route distance: 430 m Maximum depth: -2 m

Recommendation:

Avoid days when the south wind blows as waves can form which cloud the water; use a surface marker buoy.

GPS location: 38°59'26.29" N 1°34'10.43"E







Es Niu Blau



This beautiful open cove has an interesting complex of underwater tongues and rock formations that naturally lend themselves to exploration by snorkelers of every age, even children. If you're having a family day, you could play at finding octopi camouflaged behind their parapets of shells and stones – or choose any other marine creature... A good time is guaranteed!

Route information

Level: Family

Total route distance: 575 m

Maximum depth: -2 m

Recommendation: Keep your distance from the platform because the water there is very shallow. Also bear in mind that this cove sometimes gets waves.

Cala Olivera



The circular route that you find at this lovely virgin cove is only suitable for seasoned snorkelers and specialists in apnoea. If this is your profile, don't miss out! You'll have a wonderful time observing the marine life that inhabits its two islets, not to mention a corniced wall and a meadow of posidonia sea grass.

S'Estanyol





This east-facing cove is ideal for children because, in certain areas, the water is only about a metre deep. Dive in to find porgies, sea cucumbers, white seabream, croakers and sponges. Explore the perfectly preserved meadows of posidonia sea grass that are anchored in white sand. You'll also see a great underwater rock and a sunken wall, cornice and all.



Es Figueral - Caló Roig



This kayaking route is one of the simplest and most beautiful in Santa Eulària. It starts at Es Figueral beach and heads south past Punta de S'Albadar, the islet of s'Hort, Punta Verda and Caló des Roig, a little cove that is inaccessible on foot but offers sea travellers a haven where they can rest and swim.

Level: Easy

Total route distance: 5.3 km **Estimated time:** 1 h 30 m

Departure point: Es Figueral beach

Recommendation: If you're a beginner, only undertake this outing when the sea is calm.

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Out at sea, another Ibiza awaits you! Cliffs, islets and coves that are inaccessible by land, as well as reefs, promontories, caves and sailors' havens will all pass before your wondering eyes as you begin to wend your way up and down our coastline. Many excursions are possible, although the following four routes stand out for their uniqueness.





Canal d'en Martí – Tagomago Island



Tagomago Island affords kayakers one of Ibiza's most attractive outings due to its unique geology. Don't just sit there gazing at if from a distance! Take the dare and explore this route that sets off from Canal d'en Martí, crosses over to Tagomago, and then circumnavigates the islet, revealing singular rock strata, cliffs, virgin shores, outcroppings, and reefs.

Total route distance: 12.2 km **Estimated time:** 2 h 30 m

Departure point: Canal d'en Martí

Recommendation:

If you'd like to join a guided group, sign up for one of the outings offered by specialised companies...





Cala Llonga - Santa Eulària River



Get ready to enjoy stunning scenery along one of Santa Eulària's least frequented – yet most beautiful – stretches of coast. Just after you set off to the north, the shoreline transforms into a succession of cliffs and virgin coves, such as Cala Blanca, which gets its name from the tone the water acquires due to the inlet's white clay mixing with the sea.

Route information

Level: Medium

Total route distance: 9 km

Estimated time: 2 h

Departure point: Cala Llonga

Recommendation:

Weave in and out of the reeds on the final stretch of the Santa Eulària River.





Talamanca - Cala Olivera



If you love going in for dips during your kayak excursions, don't miss this wide-ranging and attractive route! S'Estanyol, Cala Espart and Cala Olivera will pass temptingly before your eyes along with other virgin coves that are not accessible by land, such as Cala Roja. You'll also encounter ridges of posidonia sea grass, caves and curious rock formations.

Level: Medium

Total route distance: 12.9 km **Estimated time:** 2 h 30 m **Departure point:** Talamanca

Recommendation: In summer, you can quench your thirst and replenish your strength at the beach bars Punta des Andreus,

S'Estanyol and Cala Olivera.







Llosa Figueral



To the southeast of Es Figueral beach, an underwater mountain awaits you with several immersion options, this circular route being one. The dive first descends to a -5 m platform, and then goes down to between -20 and -30 metres, finally returning via a sandy corridor. What will you see? Moray eels, red scorpionfish, croakers, sponges, spirographs, Mediterranean barracuda, etc.

Level: Low / medium **Maximum depth:** -32 m




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The crystalline waters of our coast don't just look pretty in pictures: they also lend diving excursions a heightened luminosity that can filter all the way down to 40 metres deep! The subaquatic realm features rock walls and posidonia meadows that are home to teeming plant and animal life, including bass, moray eels, snappers, octopi, cuttlefish, sponges, starfish, croakers and more... Enjoy your dive!





Tagomago North, Las Anclas



Whether you're a beginner or an expert, at this spot north of Tagomago you'll find an immersion that suits your skill level. If you're still a small fry, you can stay at depths of between -15 and -5 metres. If you already swim like a marlin, you can go down to -35 metres to explore centenarian anchors and Lobster Way.



Lladó Sur



About three miles from Ibiza harbour, you'll find two islets known as the Lladó, where dives can be conducted for every skill level. One of the most attractive routes explores the NE face of the south islet. Here you'll discover nooks where octopi and moray eels hide, a succession of rocks to reconnoitre, a tunnel, and surfaces covered in false coral and sea anemones.



Llosa Santa Eulària



The focal point of this dive is an underwater slab of rock that projects out into the sea and is responsible for having sunk at least one boat, the vestiges of which still lie underwater. Nearby you can also see the remains of two beacon towers that were knocked down by storms. In addition to these finds, you're sure to run into a few octopi, moray eels, dentex and seabream.



Among the activities organised by the Santa Eulalia Yacht Club, those offered year round include: sailing, swimming, kayaking and fishing. If you visit us in the summer, you'll be able to learn sailing and windsurfing, with sessions in both the morning and the afternoon. And, if you're travelling with young seafarers, they can also take kayaking. Don't leave for next summer what you can do this one: take advantage of the opportunities that the club and the island so conveniently roll out.
